


Did you know men can get breast cancer too? We all have breast tissue, so it's important for everyone to know the signs and symptoms of breast cancer.





Check all parts of your chest, your armpits and up to your collarbone (upper chest) for **changes**.







A **lump or swelling** in the chest or armpit

Touch and look at

A **nipple change**, for example it has become pulled in (inverted) or changed direction **Unusual liquid** (discharge) from either nipple
