We want everyone affected by breast cancer to get the best possible treatment, care and support. That's why we use our voice, and work alongside other charities, to campaign for the things that people affected by breast cancer need – from better screening and diagnosis to access to treatments.



## WE'VE HAD SOME AMAZING CAMPAIGN SUCCESSES, AND WE COULDN'T HAVE DONE IT WITHOUT YOU.

- With the support of patient advocates we helped ensure life-extending secondary breast cancer drugs like Kadcyla, Perjeta and Trodelvy are available on the NHS across the UK. This could help give people with incurable secondary breast cancer more time
- We helped the potentially life-saving primary breast cancer drug, olaparib, become approved for use on the NHS. This could enable certain women to have a future free from breast cancer
- We successfully called for the NHS in England to run a breast screening awareness campaign, to encourage more women to attend screening when invited. Screening can pick up breast cancer at the earliest stages. And the sooner breast cancer is diagnosed, the more effective treatment is likely to be. So, more women attending screening could mean more lives saved from breast cancer

By wearing it pink and raising money, you could help fund more vital campaigns. Pushing for more people to get diagnosed earlier, be able to get treatments and be supported to live well.
