Breast Cancer Now’s Nursing Conference 2024 was attended by 155 breast care nurses and other nurses working with breast patients. The nursing conference was evaluated through both online and physical surveys which asked delegates to consider their experience and interaction with all sessions of the conference. This evaluation is based on a survey of 100 delegates.

Conference experience

98% of respondents indicated they **would recommend the nursing conference** to other colleagues
